Levels	<b>Master Class international</b>	Saturday 12.08.2023
	<b>Level M (national)</b>	Friday 11.08.2023
	<b>Level L (national)</b>	Friday 11.08.2023
	<b>Level A (national)</b>	The A Level only takes place if the number of participants in the higher levels allows it.
Start number	The start numbers are given by the organizer. The number is then brought by the riders themselves (e.g. head number)	
Tests	<b>Dressage</b>	Classes A, L and M according to the ARSETS dressage programs. Class S rides the international dressage program according to WAVE with music.
	<b>Ease of Handling / Maniabilité</b>	All classes 8-14 obstacles according to the obstacles guide (permissible obstacles per class are defined).
	<b>Speed Test</b>	Classes L, M and S with 8-14 obstacles according to the obstacle guide (permissible obstacles per class are defined). Attention: the speed test takes place on the riding arena of the Horse Park Dielsdorf in front of the grandstand.
Vaccinations	<b>A start is only possible with presentation of the valid vaccination card. The FEI regulations apply to the International Master Class.</b>	
Equipment	The ARSETS equipment guideline applies to the equipment. Helmets (or helmet shells) are compulsory for all classes in the obstacle course. Other headgear is also permitted in the dressage test.

Late Entry	From 21st July 2023 with late inscription fee: CHF 40.00 (schedule permitting).
Vet Check	For all horses participating in S / Master Class, Friday 11.08.2023, 6 pm – 6.30 CET (estimated). Detail VET check schedule will be communicated after the entry period ended.
Insurance	Insurance is the responsibility of the participants and must also cover the risks associated with equestrian events. The organizer declines any liability.
Overnight boxes	Horse boxes are available for overnight stays on the site and must be registered at registration. Cost per horse: CHF 100.-, including first bedding. Hay can be bought on place. Reserved boxes are ready from Friday 11.08.2023 at 12.00 pm CET and reserved until Sunday 13.08.2023, 12.00 pm CET.
Dogs	Dogs must be kept on a leash throughout the facility.
Schedule	The schedule will be created based on the number of participants. If the number of participants is too small, we reserve the right to omit individual classes or in case of too many participants the lower class A could be cancelled.
Cancellation	<b>In case of cancellation by the participant after the entry deadline, there is no right to a refund of the entry fee.</b>
