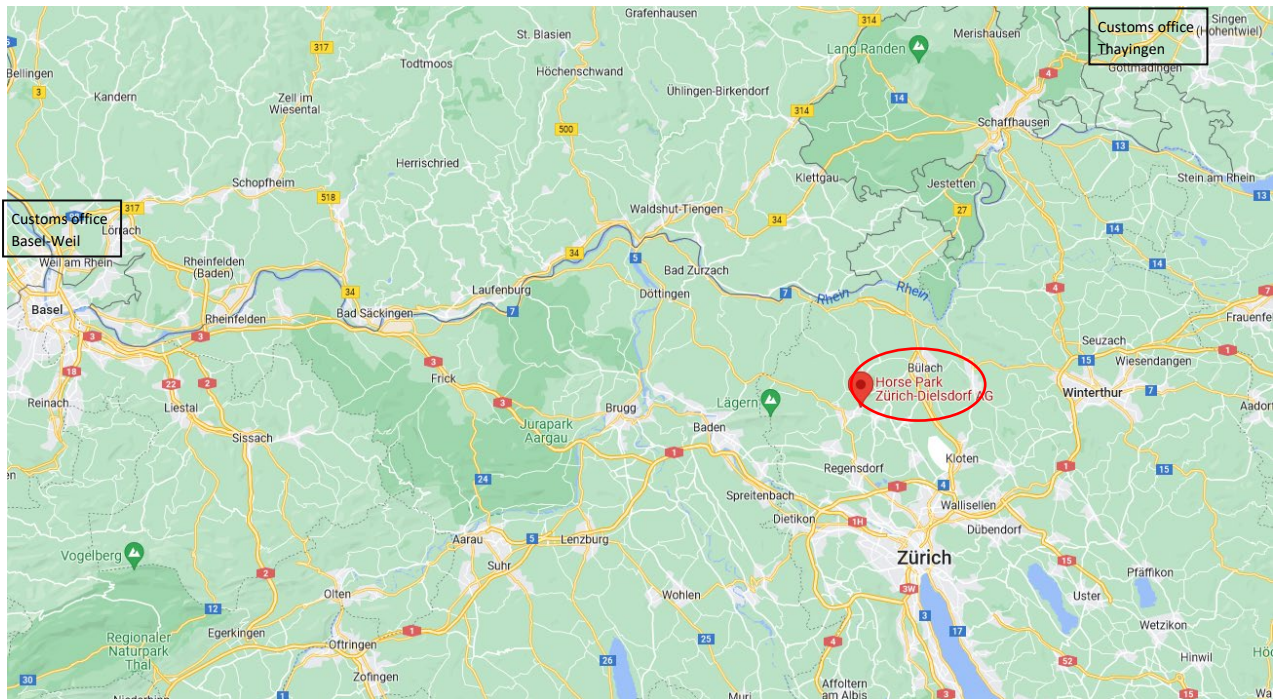


# Welcome to the Zurich Youth Masters in Zurich-Dielsdorf

## How to get there

Address for navigation: Neeracherstrasse, 8157 Dielsdorf / Google Maps: location "Zurich Youth Masters"



### From Basel, Geneva, Bern

Follow Highway A3 and later A1 direction Zurich. Leave the Highway at the exit Wettingen / Würenlos and take direction Otelfingen / Buchs / Regensdorf. **Don't go left in Buchs! This will lead to a truck driving ban!** At the first crossroad after Buchs, take a left direction Dielsdorf. At the first roundabout in Dielsdorf, take a right. Go straight at the second roundabout (on your right is a McDonald). After 300 m turn right into the Horse-Park Zurich.

### From Stuttgart, Singen (Customs office Thayngen):

Follow the A4 direction Zurich / Winterthur. Turn into the A1 in Winterthur, direction Zurich. Follow the A1 until exit Regensdorf / Zurich-Affoltern and take direction Regensdorf (right). Stay on this street until the first roundabout in Dielsdorf. Take a right. Go straight at the second roundabout (on your right is a McDonald). After 300 m turn right into the Horse-Park Zurich.

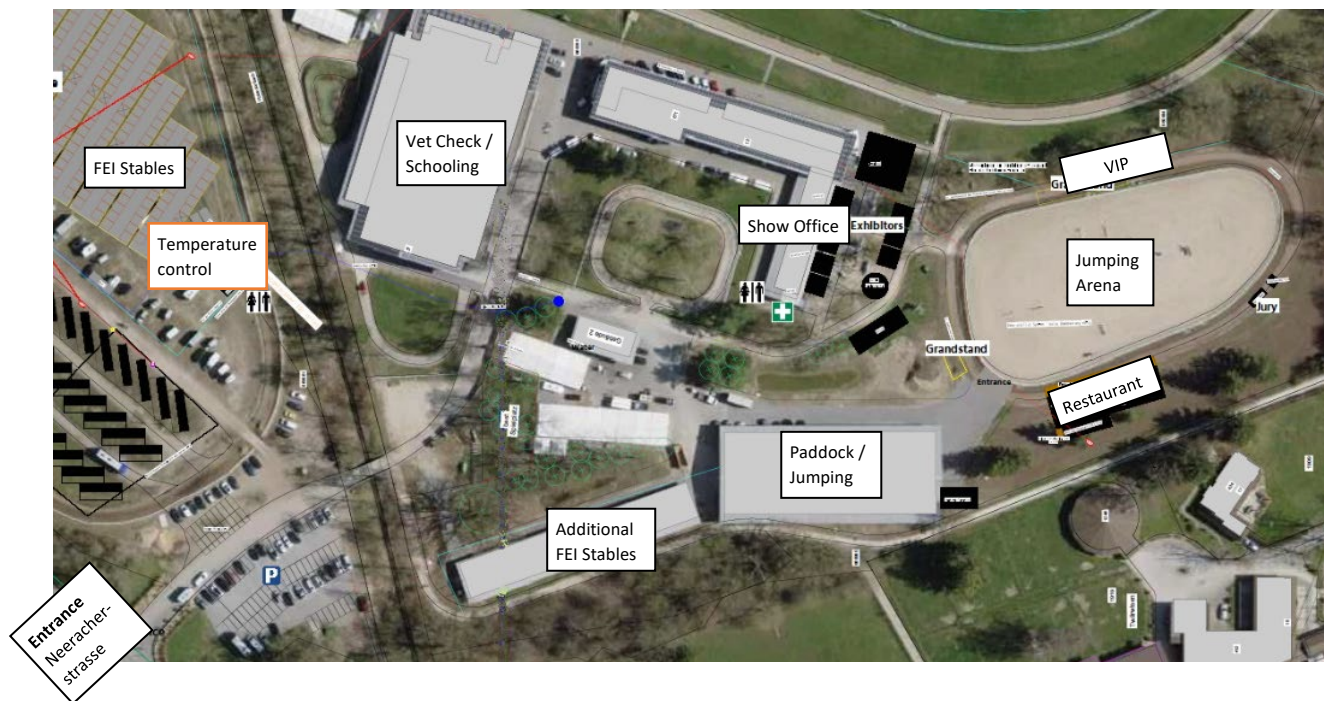
### From Munich, Austria (Customs office Au):

Turn right after the border into the A1 direction St. Gallen / Zurich. Follow the A1 until exit Regensdorf / Zurich-Affoltern and take direction Regensdorf (right). Stay on this street until the first roundabout in Dielsdorf. Take a right. Go straight at the second roundabout (on your right is a McDonald). After 300 m turn right into the Horse-Park Zurich.

### From South (Italy, San Gottardo):

Take the A2 north direction Luzern / Zurich. In Luzern follow the A4 direction Zurich. Turn into the A1 direction Winterthur / St. Gallen and pass the "Gubrist" tunnel. Take the exit Regensdorf / Zurich-Affoltern right after the tunnel and take direction Regensdorf (right). Stay on this street until the first roundabout in Dielsdorf. Take a right. Go straight at the second roundabout (on your right is a McDonald). After 300 m turn right into the Horse-Park Zurich.

### Stable

**The opening of the Stables is on Tuesday 19.08.2025, 01.00 pm. Earlier arrival is not possible due to an event the week before.** Examination on arrival is only possible during the following time:

Tuesday, 19.08.2025	01.00 pm – 07.00 pm
Wednesday, 20.08.2025	08.00 am – 10.00 am

Early arrivals and arrivals outside this time slots have to be announce no later than Saturday, 16.08.2025 by e-mail to [info@eventclearing.lu](mailto:info@eventclearing.lu) and will be charged with € 50.- per horse. Latest departure time is Monday, 25.08.2025, 08.00. Stables will be secured from Wednesday to Sunday. Stables are open daily from 06.00 to 22.00. Entrance to the stables is only granted to persons with a wristband (rider, groom or owner). Dogs are not permitted in the stables at all. Hay and shavings to buy daily 07.00 – 10.00 and 16.00 – 18.00 at the stable office.

### Lorry and Caravan Parking

The fee for caravans and lorries, with or without horses, is Euro 30.- plus Euro 100.- for electric hook-up.

**Declaration of starters:** previous evening of the respective competition by 18.00 latest on [app.eventclearing.lu](http://app.eventclearing.lu) or in the show office. The final **program** and **starting times** will be announced the evening prior to the competition on [www.youth-masters.ch/en/program](http://www.youth-masters.ch/en/program) or printed in the show office.

### Price giving ceremony

We invite the first **six riders** and horses of each competition to the official price giving ceremony. In the FEI Jumping Nations Cups Youth we're expecting the first 3 teams for the ceremony with their Chef d'Equipe.

### Vaccinations

Please double check the required vaccinations according to the FEI rules. In the case of national horse passports with an FEI number (only permitted for CSI-U25 for Swiss riders and horses), one vaccination per year is sufficient according to Swiss regulations, but the last vaccination must not have been more than 6 months ago, and the basic immunization must be correct.



## Dark water dumping stations close to the Horse Park Zurich:



A1, direction to Italy (San Gottardo): **service area Birrhard Mägenwil**

A1, north tangent Zurich, only 10 Min. from Dielsdorf: **service area Bülach both directions**

A1, direction Munich / Austria, between Zurich and Winterthur: **service area Kempthal, both directions**

A3, direction Italy (San Bernadino): **service area Aspholz**, direction north only.
